
Feedback Analysis

Students Feedback on Curriculum

G S Science, Arts and Commerce College Khamgaon has taken online feedback on curriculum by the students on prescribed syllabi of the various courses taught in our institute. We have received 162 responses from the students of various courses in online as well as offline mode. The questionnaire has 7 questions that are shown in table no.1 and table no. 2 along with the observed data.

- 75.31% of the respondents are of the opinion that the current prescribed syllabi of various courses are fulfilling their needs. They also feel that that the current syllabi serve the purpose.
- In regard of relevance to real life applicability, 62.96% respondents have agreed to this objective.
- Most of the respondents 74.07% are of the opinion that sequence of topics in the syllabi are well arranged.
- Regarding assessment of the syllabi in relation to technical advancement 68.52% respondents opine that curriculum meets the demands of the same.

- In relation to scope of the syllabi prescribed by the affiliating university 62.34 % respondents are of opinion that the scope of the syllabi is manageable to learn within stipulated period of the semester.
- About 43.21 % of the respondents expressed the opinion that the prescribed syllabi of the course are carrier oriented.
- 56.17% respondents agreed that the prescribed practical hours are enough to have practical knowledge of the syllabi.

Teachers Feedback on Curriculum

The number of responses received from teachers is 39. Among these responses 87.17 % teachers are of the opinion that the prescribed syllabi have potential enough to fulfill the objectives. In context to suitability of the syllabi 89.74% teachers are in favor of suitability of syllabi. About 66.67 % teachers observed that the current syllabi are need based. The level of the course is adequate, competent and at par with the syllabi of other universities. The observed data is compiled in table no.3

45.85% of the alumni responded that the given syllabi are industry need based. Regarding size of the syllabi 85.71% of the respondents feel that it is up to the mark. Feedback on teachers by student

The feedback of teachers by the students is compiled in table no. 6. about 88.44 students responded positively in regard of the teachers' regularity, their interests, communication skills of the teachers and using technology in the classroom.

According to the students 88.44% of the teachers are regular in their work, 87.72% teachers prepares well for their course work. The percentage of teachers having good communication skills and who are prompt in completing their syllabi work is 91.69% and 92.06% respectively. About 62.45% teachers are using ICT tools in delivering their lectures, 88.88% of the teachers are transparent in internal assessment marks. More than 83.03% of teachers are well acquainted with the students' strength and weaknesses. About 90.97% teachers encourage students in extracurricular activities. The feedback of the student community leads obviously to the conclusion that the teachers are well in doing their work.

Feedback on Infrastructure by student

The feedback of infrastructure is compiled in table no. 7. 54. The respondents have given positive responses on infrastructure.

It is submitted that 52.63 % respondents are of the opinion that classrooms are in good condition; 68.42% of them opine that laboratories are up to the mark; 63.15% respondents are happy about drinking water facilities available in the institution; 68.42% of the respondents agreed that college campus remains clean always. Most of the students are happy in regard of the facilities of auditorium, swimming pool and indoor stadium. Nearly 57.89%, 63.16% and 73.68% of the students are satisfied with the internet, xerox and sport facilities respectively available in the institution. 68.42% are of the opinion that college website is ever updated.

The data of various students are recorded on various issues available in library. Most of the respondents are satisfied about books available in library, availability of magazines and newspapers, availability of previous year's examination papers. 92.85% students are happy about the accessing time of the library. More than 80% respondents are of the opinion that reading facility and cataloging facility available in the library are satisfactory. 85.71% of the respondents are happy about the behavior of other library staff. 78.57% of the students agreed that internet facilities available in the library are good.


